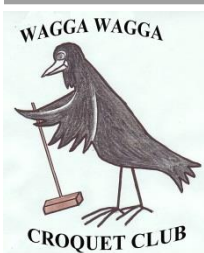


BESS WEBSTER AWARD Please give some thought as to your vote for the Bess Webster Award for 2014.
